

Kirkland Museum Photography Policy

Still photography, taken in existing light, is permitted in the Museum's galleries for private, noncommercial use only. Photographs cannot be published, sold, reproduced, transferred, distributed, or otherwise commercially exploited in any manner whatsoever. Works of art on loan from private collections or other institutions may not be photographed. Ask at the front desk to determine if any works on display are on loan. The use of a flash is prohibited. Movie and video cameras are prohibited.

Renée should also be contacted for photographs of works of art owned by the Museum for any purpose other than private and noncommercial.

The Museum reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to withhold and/or withdraw permission to photograph on its premises or to reproduce photographs of objects in its collection.
